1. Preventing Data Leakage

With the use of technology in today's office, data is captured and stored in many places. If equipment containing sensitive data is not properly disposed, the information may fall into the wrong hands.

These systems may contain hard drives, memory devices, and additional medium designed to preserve data, even when power is removed.
