The administration is moving forward with regulations regarding health care reform. There has been some discussion about allowing states a little more flexibility and/or the potential to opt out of health reform and run their own state based systems.

California lawmakers are working on legislation to conform the state tax code to the federal income tax code regarding insurance coverage for dependents up to age 26. Similar to federal law, California would allow those dependents to be taken on a pre-tax basis, and would permit an exemption for retiree only plans and stand alone medical and dental

plans.
