
SUBJECT: Application Processing Time Snapshot Reports

At the February 4, 2015 meeting, the Disability Procedures & Services Committee voted to add two additional snapshot reports addressing application processing times and pending applications by elapsed time since application date. The Board adopted proposed changes on July 12, 2012.

Note: All applications submitted prior to July 12, 2012 have been processed.


The following chart shows the total processing time from receipt of the application to the first Board action for all cases on the September 7, 2016 Disability Retirement Applications Agenda.
