		You requested records for "any and all retired employees which are paid a monthly pension annuity, in electronic format and emailed for the year 2017. This data should include the following data items: Year of 2017, Last Name, Years of Service, Zip Code of Residence."				
		Taking into account LACERA's obligation to narrowly construe statutes limiting disclosure, see Cal. Const., art. I, § 3, (b)(2), LACERA has nonetheless determined as discussed further below that certain of the records you requested are exempt from disclosure under the CPRA.				
		Government Code §6254 (c) exempts "Personnel, medical, or similar files, the disclosure of which would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The "Zip Code of Residence" that you requested is part of the Personnel file information that this section exempts from disclosure.				
		Government Code §6254.3 exempts "home addresses and other personal information from public disclosure." The "Zip Code of Residence" that you requested is part of the information that this section exempts from disclosure.				
		Public records are exempt from disclosure under the CPRA if they are records, "the disclosure of which is exempted or prohibited pursuant to federal or state law." (Government Code §6254(k)). Here, disclosure of the records you requested is expressly prohibited by Section 31532 of the County Employees Retirement Law of 1937, set forth at California Government Code Section 31450 <u>et seq.</u> , (the "Retirement Law").				
		Section 31532 of the Retirement Law provides, in full:

		Accordingly, absent an order by a court of competent jurisdiction or member authorization, LACERA cannot provide the "Zip Code of Residence" information you requested. These records are thus also exempt from disclosure under Section 6254(k) of the CPRA. However, the other records you requested are not exempt from disclosure, including the "Year of 2017, Last Name, Years of Service" information. We have collected this information and attached it with this response in the format requested.					
		As directed by Article 1, Section 3 of the California State Constitution, LACERA has narrowly construed the application of exemptions to the withholding of any records made under your request. Further, under Government Code §6253.1, if you believe we have misconstrued the nature or scope of your request, we offer to assist you in clarifying them.
